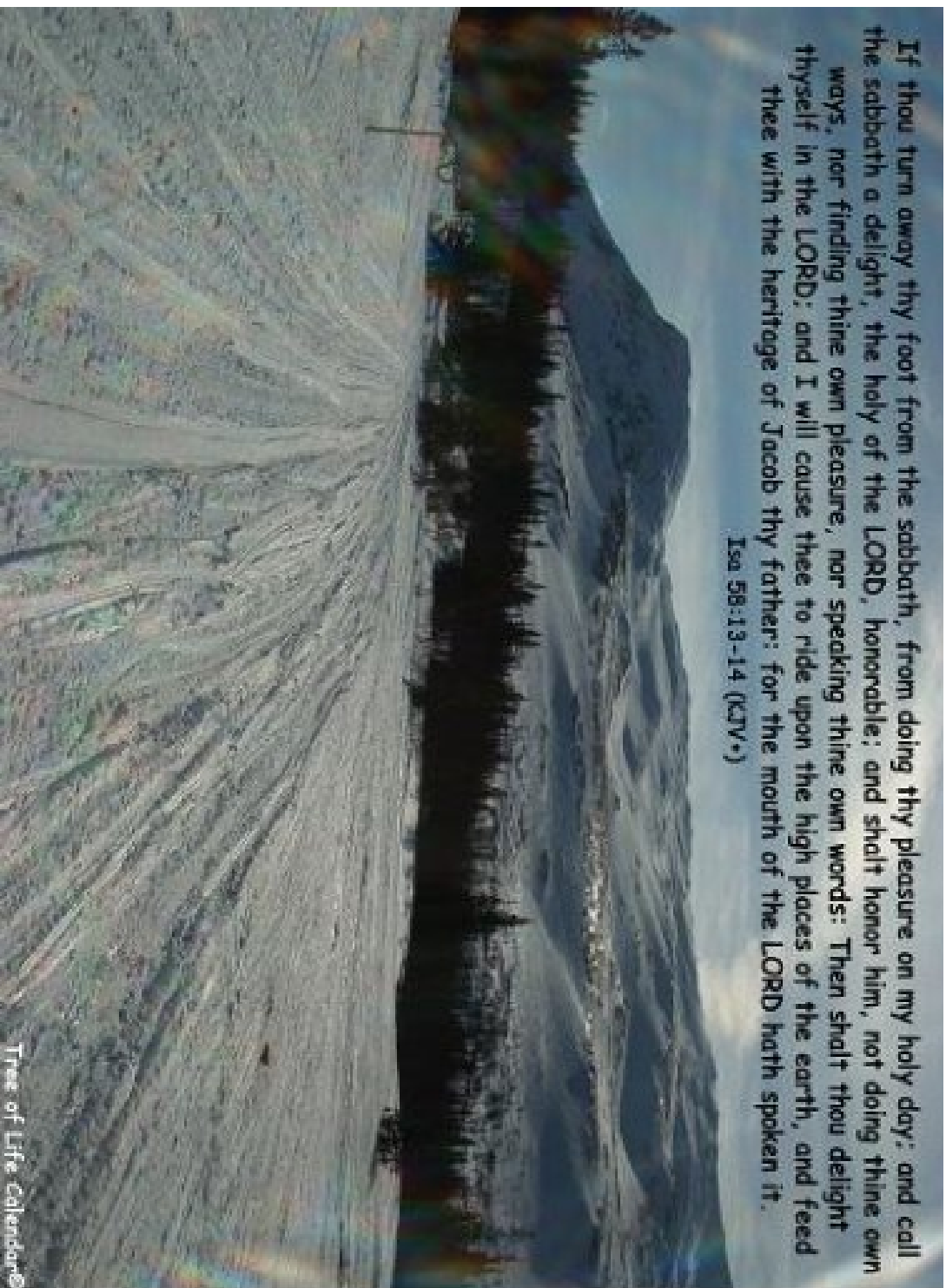

Notice: In the Biblical, Jewish and Hijri calendars the day/date always begins at sunset the day before.

Biblical: 7th day of the week - Sabbath
Gregorian (Swe): Every Sunday - Sondag; 6th of January - Tretondag jul
Gregorian (USA): 6th of January - Epiphany; 16th of January - Martin Luther King Jr's Birthday
Jewish: 7th day of the week - Sabbath; 2nd of Tevet - Asara B'Tevet; Asara B'Tevet; 1st of Shevat - Rosh Chodesh Shvat
Hijri: Dhu al-Hijjah; 8-10th - Hajj (Pilgrimage to Mecca); 9th - Day of Arafat; 10-13th - Eid-ul-Adha (The Festival of Sacrifice - Commemorates Abraham's sacrifice)
 18th - Eid al-Adha; 1st of Muharram - Ras as-sana'h (Islamic New Year) (Year 1427 begins)
Chinese: 12/29 Spring Festival Eve; 1/1-1/3 - Spring Festival (The Chinese New Year) (Year 4643 begins)
