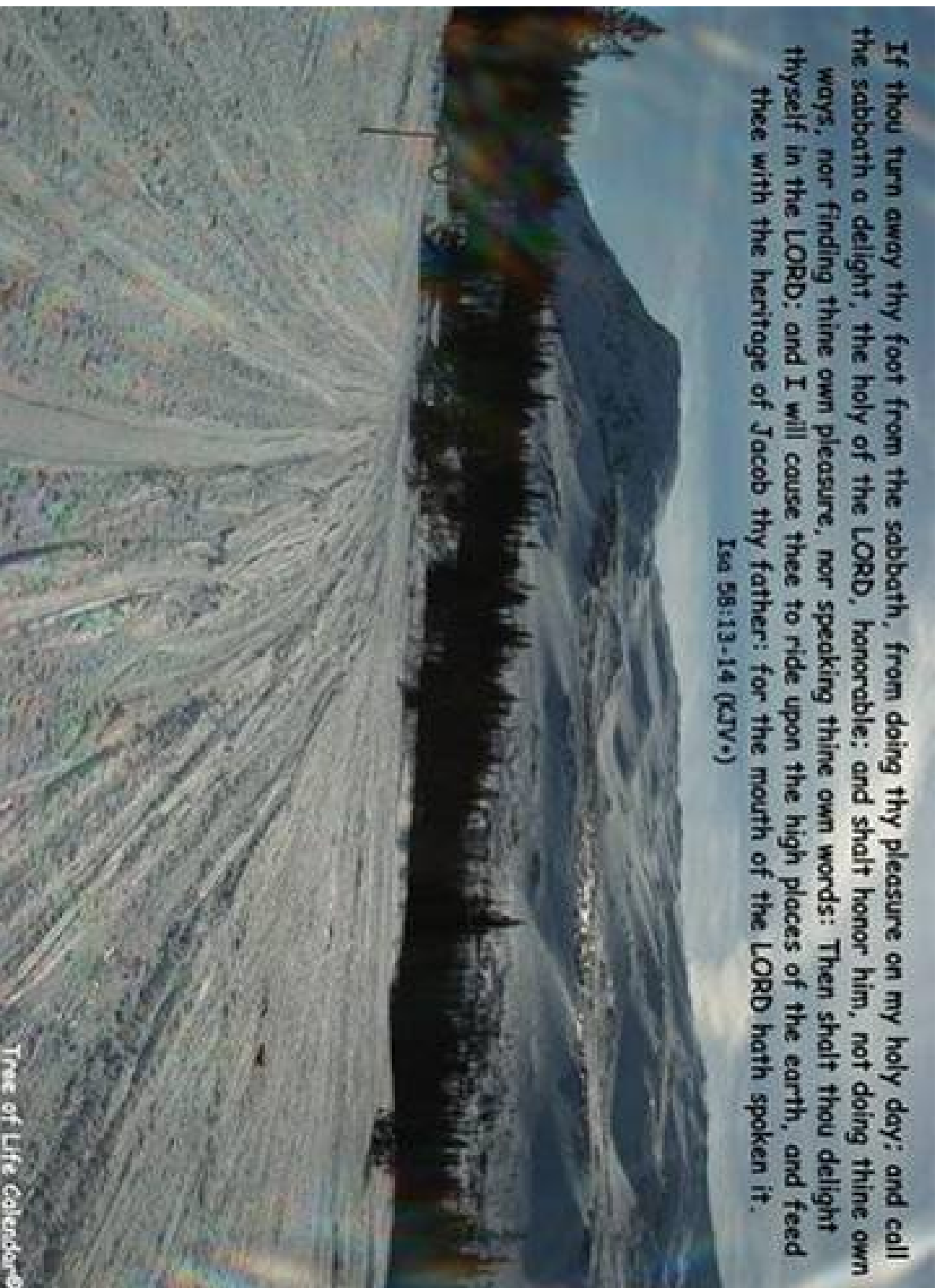

 Gregorian (Swe): Every Sunday - Söndag; 6th of January - Trettondag jul  
 Gregorian (USA): 6th of January - Epiphany; 16th of January - Martin Luther King Jr's Birthday  
 Jewish: 7th day of the week - Sabbath; 2nd of Tevet - 8th Day of Chanukah; 10th of Tevet - Asara BTevet; 1st of Shevat - Rosh Chodesh Shvat  
 Hijri: Dhu al-Hijjah: 8-10th - Hajj (Pilgrimage to Mecca); 9th - Day of Arafat; 10-13th - 'Eid-ul-Adha (The Festival of Sacrifice - Commemorates Abraham's sacrifice)  
 18th - Eid al-Ghadir; 1st of Muharram - Ras-assanah (Islamic New Year) (Year 1427 begins)  
 Chinese: 12/29 Spring Festival Eve; 1/1-1/3 - Spring Festival (The Chinese New Year) (Year 4643 begins)
