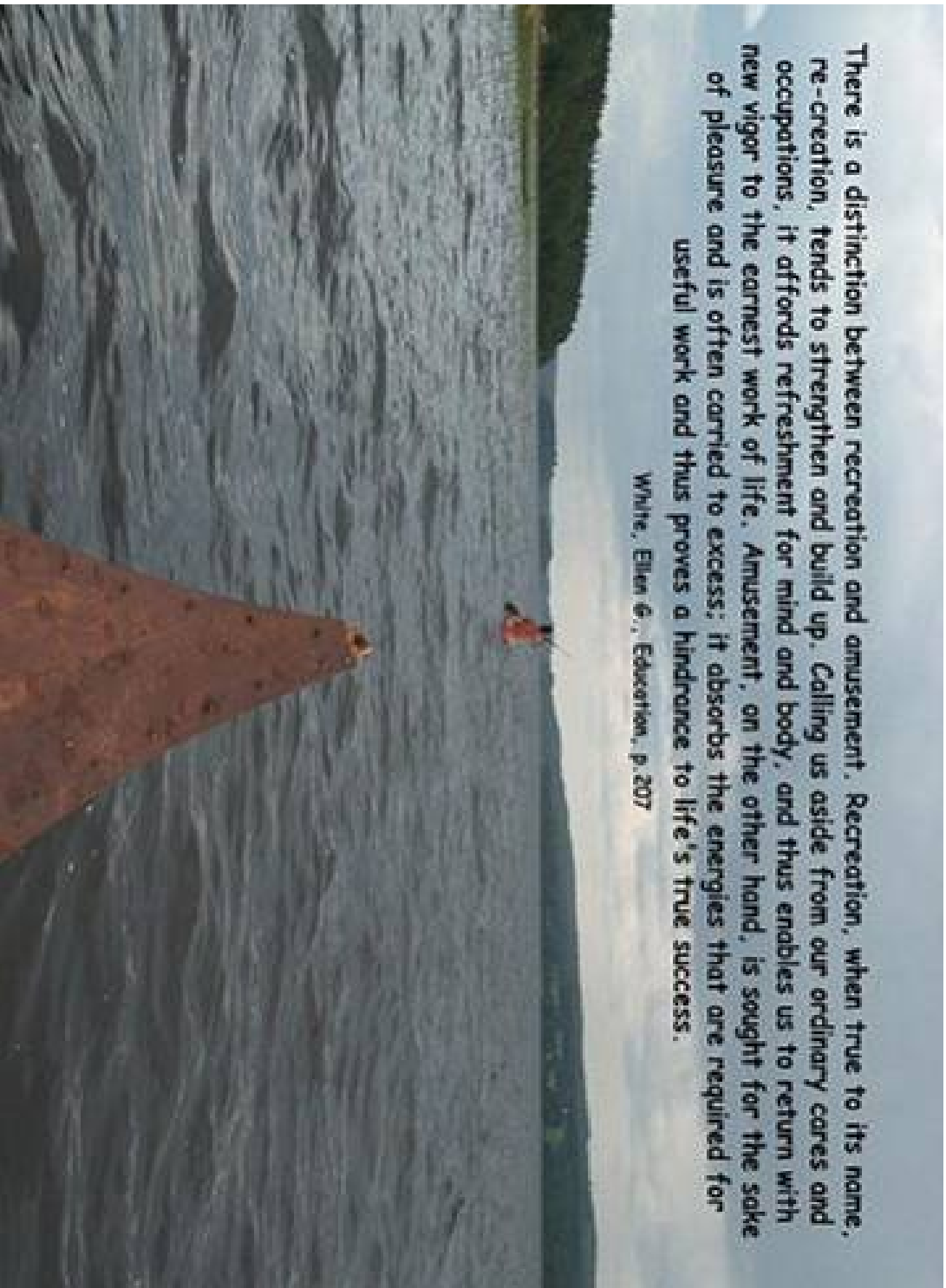

**Colored Days**

*Notice: In the Biblical, Jewish and Hijri calendars the day/date always begins at sunset the day before.*

**Biblical:** 7th day of the week - Sabbath. The 7th weekly Sabbath after the base Sabbath - The feast of weeks (Hag Ha-Shavuot) (Continue the Sabbath of the Omer count from the prior month! The 7th Sabbath of the Omer is The feast of weeks.)  
**Gregorian (Swe):** Every Sunday - Söndag. 4th of June - Pingsdagen. 6th of June - Sveriges nationaldag. 21st of June - Sommarståndet. 24th of June - Midsommardagen. Johannes doparens dag  
**Gregorian (USA):** 29th of May - Memorial day. 11th of June - Father's day. 14th of June - Flag day. 21st of June - First Day of Summer  
**Jewish:** 7th day of the week - Sabbath. 5th of Sivan - Erev Shavuot(49th (last) day of the Omer. 6. 7th of Sivan for diaspora (6th for Israel) - Shavuot (Feast of Pentecost).  
**Hijri:** 30th of Sivan and 1st Tammuz - Rosh Chodesh Tammuz  
**Chinese:** 5/5 - Duan Wu (Dragon Boat) Festival. 1st of June - Children's Day
